NOW COMES POLYGAMY AND THEN???

POLYGAMOUS TRIO APPLIES FOR MARRIAGE LICENSE

"A Montana man said Wednesday that he was inspired by last week's U.S. Supreme Court decision legalizing gay marriage to apply for a marriage license so that he can legally wed his second wife. Nathan Collier and his wives Victoria and Christine applied at the Yellowstone County Courthouse in Billings on Tuesday in an attempt to legitimize their polygamous marriage. Montana, like all 50 states, outlaws bigamy - holding multiple marriage licenses - but Collier said he plans to sue if the application is denied. "It's about marriage equality," Collier told The Associated Press Wednesday. "You can't have this without polygamy....."

"...We just want to add legal legitimacy to an already happy, strong, loving family," Nathan Collier told KTVQ. The three have seven children of their own and from previous relationships. "My second wife Christine, who I'm not legally married to, she's put up with my **** for a lot of years. She deserves legitimacy," he said.

"It's two distinct marriages, its two distinct unions, and for us to come together and create family, what's wrong with that?" said Christine. "I don't understand why it's looked upon and frowned upon as being obscene...."
